3.1 Work stoppages are emergency measures adopted in case of working conditions that expose a worker to imminent and serious danger.

3.1.1 Imminent and serious danger is considered any working condition or situation that may cause occupational accidents or diseases that lead to serious damage to the physical integrity of the worker.

3.2 Stoppage of work or prohibition implies total or partial suspension of the establishment, service sector, machine or equipment.

3.3 Work stoppage implies a total or partial suspension of a construction.

3.3.1 Construction implies any and all construction engineering, building, installation, maintenance or renovation services.

3.4 During work stoppages, necessary activities to correct the situation of imminent and serious danger can be performed, provided that appropriate protection measures regarding the workers involved are adopted.

3.5 During work stoppages, employees shall receive their salaries as if they were actively working.
